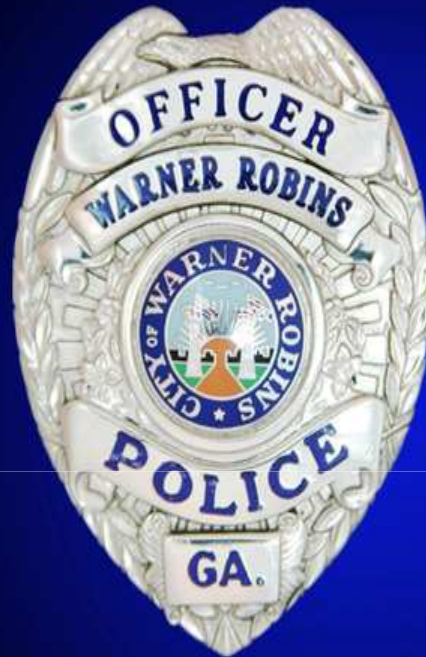

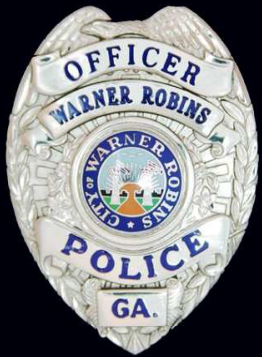

Warner Robins, GA



- Geographically located in the heart of Georgia
- Accessible by I-75 and I-16
- Population of Houston County was estimated at 116,768
- First class school system (Houston County School System)
- Home to several colleges:
 - Macon State College (Warner Robins Campus)
 - Georgia Military College
 - Middle Georgia Technical College

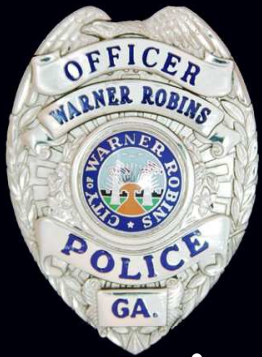


Warner Robins History



- Founded **September 1, 1942**
- Originally named **Wellston Army Air Corp Depot** for local farmers
- Named after Brigadier General Augustine Warner Robins
- In **1947**, the U.S. Air Force instituted Robins Air Force Base
- The 2000 Census totaled the population to over 48,000 people

Robins Air Force Base

- **1940s:** Served as an aviation supply and repair depot
- Named after Brig Gen Augustine Warner Robins
 - **“Father of Logistics”** in the modern U.S. Air Force
- One of the top **suppliers** of parts and center for repairs during wars
- **2004:** RAFB and the Warner Robins Air Logistics Center is the single largest industrial complex in Georgia
- Home of the Award Winning **Museum of Aviation** since 1981



Warner Robins Police Department



WRPD 1940s

- Established in **1944** under the command of Chief Martin
- Employed **4 full time** police officers
- First patrol car purchased in **1946**
- Employed seven full time police officers by 1949

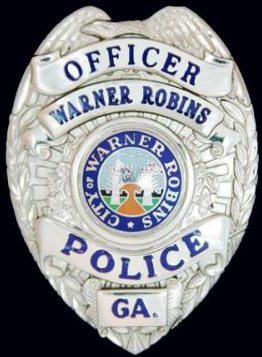

WRPD 1950s

- Added first **Harley motorcycle** in 1954
- Hired first **patrolwomen (4)**
- Implemented **12 hour shifts**
- Maintained **12 full time** patrol officers

Warner Robins Police Department



WRPD 1960s

- Grown to **34 full time officers**
- **6 patrol vehicles** purchased
- Back to **8 hours**
- Hired 3 new **patrolwomen**
 - 1 of which was **certified**

WRPD 1970s – 1990s

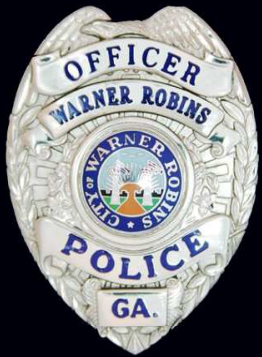
- Citizens on Patrol
